SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1627, L.D. 2295,  
Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a Commission to Implement  
Computerization of Criminal History Record Informa-  
tion."

Amend the bill in section 5 by inserting at the  
end a new sentence to read:

'The cost of these consultant services shall be pro-  
rated between the participating departments and paid  
out of their current operating budgets.'

Further amend the bill in section 8 by striking  
out all of the last line (page 4, line 18 in L.D.)  
and inserting in its place the following:

Further amend the bill in the fiscal note, in the
