28 29 30 31	Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1986 hereinafter mentioned be immediately as- sessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and

3 Sec. 1. Kennebec County; taxes apportioned. Re-4 solved: That the following sum is hereby granted as 5 a tax on Kennebec County to be apportioned, assessed, 6 collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts 7 and necessary expenses of the county as authorized 8 herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calen-9 dar year 1986:
