HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1641, L.D. 2315, Bill, "AN CT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund to Implement Recommendations of the Visiting Committee to the University of Maine and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1987."

Amend the Bill in section 5 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'A tax is imposed on retail sales at the rate of 5% on the value of all tangible personal property, on telephone and telegraph service and, on extended cable television services and upon the rental charged for living quarters in hetels, reeming houses, teurist or trailer camps and the rental charged for automobiles rented on a short-term basis, other than a rental charged to a person engaged in the business of renting automobiles, and at a rate of 7% on the rental charged for living quarters in hotels, rooming houses, touris or trailer camps measured by the sale price, except as in chapters 211 to 225 provided. Retailers shall pay such tax at the time and in the manner provided, and it shall be in addition to all other taxes.

Further amend the Amendment in the Fiscal Note in the 8th line (page 26, line 8 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sections 5 and 6" and inserting in its place the following: 'Section 6"
