25 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
26 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
27 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

28 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
29 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

30 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
31 dent to the operation of these institutions may be-
32 come due and payable before that effective date; and

33 Whereas, some projects contemplated with this
34 funding can be accomplished more effectively during
35 the summer; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
8 follows:

9 Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
10 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
11 of this Act.
