COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 930, L.D. 2317, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Universal Telephone Service Program."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Assist Low-income Telephone Users.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the first 3 lines after the enacting clause (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. 35 MRSA §74-A is enacted to read:

§74-A. Low-income telephone assistance'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§74-A" in subsection 2 in the 3rd paragraph in the next to the last line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "quarterly" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'semiannual'
