1 The following vehicles are exempt from this subsec-2 tion, provided that they are equipped with dual con-3 trols as stated in this section and comply with any 4 other requirements of this chapter: 5 A. Any vehicle, specially equipped for use by a handicapped person, which is being used to in-6 7 struct a handicapped person; and 8 B. Any vehicle which is being used to instruct a 9 person in possession of a valid Maine driver's 10 license or instruction permit not provided by the 11 driving school.

STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The purpose of this new draft is to create an ex-14 emption in the driver education law to allow handi-15 capped persons and persons with a valid Maine driver's license or instruction permit to receive 16 driver education in their own vehicles. This new 17 18 draft modifies enabling language to clarify the con-19 ditions in which driver education can occur within the vehicle owned by the person receiving instruc-20 21 tion.
