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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1660, L.D. 2338,
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue for
Androscoggin County to Raise Funds for Renovations to
the County Building and County Jail."

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Amend the bill by inserting after the title and
before the enacting clause the following:

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'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the renovations to the Androscoggin
County building and jail are immediately necessary;
and

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Whereas, without passage of this measure as emer-
gency legislation these renovations will be unneces-
sarily delayed; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

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'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
when approved.'
