18 AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue for  
19 Androscoggin County to Raise Funds for  
20 Renovations to the County Building and  
21 County Jail.  
22

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
24 follows:

25 Sec. 1. To raise money for renovations to the  
26 county building and county jail. Notwithstanding the  
27 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 404, the  
28 county commissioners of Androscoggin County are au-  
29 thorized to raise and expend, by issuing bonds or  
30 notes, a sum not exceeding \$450,000 to be used for  
31 the following purposes:

32 1. To make renovations to the county jail for  
33 the purpose of constructing a juvenile detention ar-  
34 ea;

35 2. To make renovations to the county building to  
36 increase handicapped accessibility; and

1           3. To make energy conservation improvements to  
2 the county building.

3           **Sec. 2. Aid from other sources.** The county com-  
4 missioners of Androscoggin County are authorized to  
5 borrow any portion of the sums authorized by this Act  
6 from or through any agency or department of the State  
7 and of the Federal Government. The county commis-  
8 sioners are authorized to receive grants of money and  
9 other assistance from or through any agency or de-  
10 partment of the State and of the Federal Government  
11 for any of the purposes authorized in this Act.

12           **Sec. 3. Bonds or notes.** To provide funds for the  
13 renovations to the jail and the county building, the  
14 treasurer of Androscoggin County, with the approval  
15 of the county commissioners, may borrow from time to  
16 time upon the full faith and credit of the county  
17 such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate \$450,000,  
18 as may be necessary and may issue bonds or notes  
19 which shall bear on their face the words  
20 "Androscoggin County Capital Improvement Bonds Act of  
21 1986." Each authorized issue shall be payable in such  
22 annual installments, beginning not more than 2 years  
23 from the date, as will extinguish each loan in not  
24 more than 10 years from its date. The bonds or notes  
25 shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and  
26 countersigned by the chairman of the county commis-  
27 sioners. The bonds shall be valid without first ob-  
28 taining the consent of the county, as provided in the  
29 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, sections 302 and  
30 404. The county may sell these securities at public  
31 or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the  
32 county commissioners deem proper, but at not less  
33 than par and accrued interest.

34           **Sec. 4. Temporary notes.** The county treasurer,  
35 with the approval of the county commissioners, may  
36 issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not  
37 more than one year from their dates, in anticipation  
38 of the issue of serial bonds or notes under this Act  
39 and may renew the same, but the time within which the  
40 serial bonds or notes become due and payable shall  
41 not, by reason of these temporary notes, be extended  
42 beyond the term fixed by this Act. Any notes issued  
43 in anticipation of the serial bonds or notes shall be  
44 paid from the proceeds of the bonds.
