18 AN ACT to Provide Funds for the Teacher of
19 the Year Program.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 20-A MRSA §13803 is enacted to read:

24 §13803. Teacher of the Year

25 The commissioner may award up to \$2,000 from the
26 General Fund to the Teacher of the Year for travel
27 and other expenses related to appearances and other
28 duties which that person may perform as Teacher of
29 the Year. In addition to those funds, reasonable ex-
30 penditures of any current or former Teacher of the Year
31 associated with the promotion of an approved project
32 under section 17102 may be awarded by the commission-
33 er from innovative educational grant funds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The original bill provided for payment of Teacher
3 of the Year expenses from the innovative educational
4 grant fund created by the education reform laws.
5 This amendment provides that up to \$2,000 of expenses
6 be paid from General Fund money. Apart from those
7 funds, the commissioner may award from innovative ed-
8 ucational grant funds reasonable expenses incurred by
9 a Teacher of the Year which are associated with the
10 promotion of a classroom based innovative educational
11 grant project approved under the Maine Revised Stat-
12 utes, Title 20-A, section 17102.

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
