HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1673, L.D. 2358,
Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Eligibility Requirements for
Licensure as a Master Electrician."

Amend the Bill in subsection 1 by striking out
all of the last paragraph and inserting in its place
the following:

'The board may establish by rule standards in accord-
ance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Ti-
tle 5, chapter 375, to exercise its discretion to de-
termine if a limited license holder applying for a
master electrician's license has adequate experience
in all phases of electrical installation to take the
examination.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make neces-
sary references to the Maine Administrative Procedure
Act, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter
375.
