2 STATEMENT OF FACT

- 3 This amendment makes the following changes in the 4 bill:
- 1. Amends the composition of the advisory committee to remove specific references for the high-risk community members and to add a member of the clergy;
- 9 2. Removes the requirement that attorneys' fees 10 be paid in court cases involving violation of this 11 Act;
- 3. Corrects a definition by changing the defined term from "person or anyone" to "person." "Person or anyone" was a phrase used in the original draft of this bill which was omitted in the new draft. The correct reference is to "person;"and
- 17 4. Corrects the title of the "Part" in the law.
 18 The title related to the sections of the bill which
 19 have been omitted by the new draft.
