STATEMENT OF FACT

Sharon Taylor was found dead on March 24, 1985, at the Pine Tree State Arboretum. Paul Addington, a resident at the Augusta Mental Health Institute, Augusta, Maine, at that time, was subsequently convicted of Sharon Taylor's murder. John P. Taylor as Personal Representative of the Estate of Sharon Taylor alleges that the State's negligence with respect to Paul Addington was the proximate cause of Sharon Taylor's death.

John P. Taylor as Personal Representative of the Estate of Sharon Taylor is barred by law from bringing any action against the State of Maine and its employees for the wrongful death of Sharon Taylor. cause of the unique circumstances of this case and because Paul Addington was a resident of the Augusta Health Institute at the time of Mental Sharon Taylor's murder, the Legislature feels that the State of Maine has a moral obligation to compensate John P. Taylor as Personal Representative of the Estate of Sharon Taylor directly for the death of Sharon Taylor. Accordingly, this resolve authorizes and directs, upon receipt of necessary releases, the Governor to use existing appropriations to structure a compensation plan which will pay to John P. as Personal Representative of the Estate of Sharon Taylor, a total of \$200,000 tax free over a period of several years. The payment authorized by this resolve is in full satisfaction of any and all claims which the estate of Sharon Taylor may have against the State and its employees for the death of Sharon Taylor.
