7 SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 950, L.D. 2380,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Confirm and Recognize Public Trust  
9 Rights in Intertidal Land."

10 Amend the bill in that part designated "§573." by  
11 striking out all of subsection 1 (page 2, lines 31 to  
12 39 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

13 '1. Public trust right. The public trust right  
14 in intertidal land includes the right to use  
15 intertidal land for fishing, fowling and navigation.'

16 Further amend the bill in that part designated  
17 "§573." in subsection 3 in the last line (page 3,  
18 line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined  
19 word and punctuation "law." the following:  
20 'Notwithstanding this section, any municipality or  
21 plantation may call upon the state police to enforce  
22 laws or rules.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This amendment restricts the public trust right  
3 to the traditional public rights of fishing, fowling  
4 and navigation. It also clearly states the state  
5 police's jurisdiction in municipalities and planta-  
6 tions.


