This purpose of this new draft is to appropriate supplemental funds to the Judicial Department. In addition it requires the Judicial Department to use the Executive Department agencies unless otherwise prohibited by law. This bill also authorizes and appropriates funds to conduct a study of the relationship between the Judicial, Executive and Legislative branches of government with respect to financial and administrative practices and procedures.
