18 AN ACT to Ratify the Vote Converting Caswell
19 Plantation to a Town.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 Referendum vote validated. The majority vote of
24 the voters of Caswell Plantation at the referendum
25 held pursuant to Private and Special Law 1985, chap-
26 ter 44 is declared to be a valid approval of that
27 Act, notwithstanding the fact that the total vote
28 cast for and against acceptance did not equal or ex-
29 ceed 50% of the total number of votes cast in the
30 plantation for Governor at the last gubernatorial
31 election preceeding the vote and Private and Special
32 Law 1985, chapter 44 is hereby declared to be ap-
33 proved in accordance with section 4 of that Act.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to ratify the vote of
Caswell Plantation converting it from a plantation to
a town.

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
