In an action alleging professional negligence 21 in the rendering of a real estate title opinion; B. In an action alleging professional negligence in the drafting of a last will and testament which has been offered for probate; and 22 23 24 25 C. As the statute of limitations may be sus-26 pended by other laws. 27 Further amend the bill in section 16 in that part designated "§8303." by striking out all of the first line (page 18, line 28 in L.D.) and inserting in its 28 29 place the following: 30 31 '§2961. Contingent fees'
