IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX
AN ACT to Revise the Salaries of Certain County Officers.
Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officials; and
Whereas, it is desired to have these revisions retroactive to January 1, 1986; and
Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser- vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill makes changes in county salaries as adopted by the county commissioners for those coun-3 4 ties which require legislative approval. Cumberland 5 and Waldo Counties have instituted municipal budget 6 committee participation and no longer require legis-7 lative approval of their budgets. Several other 8 counties also have budget committees but still re-9 quire legislative approval of the budget. York County has a county administrator and by statute the com-10 missioners forego a salary when a county has an ad-11 12 ministrator.
