15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives, beginning with the first Wednesday of December, 1984 1986 and thereafter, shall receive \$9,000 in the first year and \$6,000 in the 2nd year of each biennium, and shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week at the same rate per mile to and from his place of abode as state employees receive, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route, except that Legislators may be reimbursed for tolls paid for travel on the Maine Turnpike provided they have a receipt for payment of the tolls, such tolls to be reimbursed where Legislators use the Maine Turnpike in traveling to and from sessions of the Legislature or in performance of duly authorized committee assignments. Each Legislator is entitled to mileage on the first day of the session, and such amounts of his salary and expenses at such times as the Legislature may determine during the session, and the balance at the end thereof.

The total For each year or 7 part of a year served after June 30, 1989, the 8 allowance shall be increased by an amount equal to 9 the cost-of-living factor granted the previous Sep-10 tember, as determined pursuant to section 1358, com-11 pounded annually.
- 12 Sec. 3. PL 1985, c. 693, §14 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 14 Sec. 14. Effective date. Sections 2, 3 and 4 of 15 this Act shall be applied retroactive to July 1, 16 1986.
- Sec. 4. Effective date. The portion of this part amending the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and Title 4, section 1352, subsection 4, shall take effect 90 days after the Legislature adjourns.'
