20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 5 MRSA §17001, sub-§42, as enacted by PL 1985, c.  
23 801, §5, is amended to read:

24 42. Teacher. "Teacher" means a preschool teach-  
25 er, teacher, superintendent, principal, supervisor,  
26 school nurse, school dietician or school secretary  
27 employed in any public school, including teachers in  
28 unorganized territory.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The final version of Public Law 1985, chapter  
3 801, "AN ACT to Recodify the Laws of the Maine State  
4 Retirement System" omitted the term "teacher" from  
5 the definition of a teacher in the Maine Revised  
6 Statutes, Title 5, section 17001, subsection 42.  
7 This bill inserts that term in the definition.

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
