17 AN ACT to Amend the Liquor Laws to Allow a
18 Vessel Corporation Owned by a
19 Certificate Holder to Apply for a
20 Liquor License.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 28 MRSA §307 is enacted to read:

25 §307. Vessel corporations owned by certificate of
26 approval holders

27 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ti-
28 tle, a vessel corporation owned by a certificate of
29 approval holder and operated in international and in-
30 terstate commerce may be issued a license to sell
31 malt, vinous and spirituous liquor at retail pursuant
32 to the provisions of sections 753 and 802.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to allow a vessel
3 corporation owned by a certificate of approval holder
4 to apply for and receive a liquor license in the same
5 manner as does any other vessel corporation under
6 Maine law.

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
