COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 977, L.D. 2423, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand Veterans' Employment Benefits to Veterans of Recent Military Actions."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, an individual who is eligible for preference points under this bill may apply for a state position prior to the end of the 90-day period; and

Whereas, those qualifying individuals who applied before the end of the 90-day period will not be eligible for service points; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Legislature that all qualifying individuals should be eligible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
