The 20 21 survey shall identify asbestos and its condition as 22 well as provide the necessary information to plan removal or containment of asbestos. The commissioner and the labor-management committee shall use this survey to develop a plan for the removal and contain-23 24 25 26 ment of asbestos in state facilities. The survey and 27 the plan shall be submitted to the joint standing 28 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 29 appropriations and financial affairs. 30 The Legislature may at its discretion adopt as 31 submitted or modify this plan. Thereafter, the commissioner and the labor-management committee shall 32 report annually to the Legislature as to the imple-mentation of the plan and the expenditure of the re-33 34 35 maining funds raised by the bond issue. 36 Further amend the Bill in section 6 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "state parks, historic and river access 37 38

9	STATEMENT OF FACT
10 11	This amendment makes technical corrections to the bill and adds a fiscal note.
12 13 14	This amendment also provides for a survey of state facilities and the development of a plan for removal and containment of asbestos.
