1 2 3 4 5	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
7 8	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
9 10	36 MRSA §4403, sub-§§1 and 2, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 783, §16, are amended to read:
11 12 13 14	1. Smokeless tobacco. A tax is imposed on all smokeless tobacco, including chewing tobacco and snuff, at the rate of $45\%$ 10% of the wholesale sales price.
15 16 17	2. Other tobacco. A tax is imposed on cigars, pipe tobacco and other tobacco intended for smoking at the rate of 12% $\underline{10}$ % of the wholesale sales price.
18 19 20	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 16, 1986.
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24	The purpose of this bill is to adjust the rate of tax imposed on tobacco products pursuant to Public Law 1985, chapter 783.
