SENATE AMENDMENT " E " to S.P. 982, L.D. 2431,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Study of Solid Waste Dis-  
9 posal Policy in Maine."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title  
11 (page 1, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) and inserting in  
12 its place the following:

'AN ACT to Create a Study of Solid Waste Disposal  
14 Policy in Maine and Amend the Law Concerning Approval  
15 of Site Location of Development.'

16

Further amend the bill by inserting after the en-  
17 acting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §484-A is enacted to read:

§484-A. Compliance record

In considering whether approval should be granted  
21 under section 484, the department may consider the  
22 applicant's past record of compliance with environ-  
23 mental laws and rules and past violations, if any, of  
24 criminal laws.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-  
26 tions to read consecutively.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment allows the Department of Environmental Protection to consider past records concerning environmental criminal law violations of site location of development applicants and gives the department the authority to deny approval of the sites for past violations.
