- 3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1. Legislative study. The Joint Standing 6 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources shall con-7 duct a study of the laws and regulations governing 8 the disposal of solid waste in Maine. The committee 9 shall review and compare Maine law with the 10 other states which export solid waste to Maine for 11 disposal. The committee may request the assistance 12 of the Department of Environmental Protection and 13 other affected parties as necessary. The committee 14 make maximum use of technical data and studies 15 conducted previously by the department and other 16 agencies as appropriate. The committee shall submit 17 its report, together with any necessary legislation, 18 to the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature 19 later than March 15, 1987. The Legislative Coun-20 cil may provide staff support for the study.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
