There is created the Maine Sentencing Guidelines Commission which shall be comprised of 8 members, including the Commissioner of Corrections or his designee; 2 members of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary to be appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; a criminal defense attorney, a district attorney and 2 members of the public to be appointed by the Governor; and the Attorney General or his designee. The Governor shall select a chairman from one of these 8 voting members. In addition, a Supreme Court Justice, a Superior Court Justice and a District Court Judge, to be appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, shall serve in an advisory capacity to the commission.
32 33 34 35	Members shall be appointed within 30 days of the effective date of this Act and shall serve for the duration of the 112th Legislature. Vacancies shall be filled for the portion of the term of the member
