HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to H.P. 1748, L.D. 2433,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and In-  
consistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
emergency clause the following:

'PART C

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §7912, sub-§2, as enacted by PL  
1985, c. 770, §15, is amended to read:

2. Home and Community Based Waiver Program.  
Boarding care facilities which provide residential  
habilitation services through the Home and Community  
Based Waiver Program for persons who are mentally re-  
tarded may ~~admit~~ have as residents persons who are  
nonambulatory ~~or mobile nonambulatory~~, if:

A. The structure meets all of the requirements  
of the fire code for institutional occupancy; and

B. A physician certifies that the nonambulatory  
resident does not require nursing care. This  
certification is required at least annually.

Sec. 2. Effective date. That section of this  
Part amending the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22,  
section 7912, subsection 2 shall take effect on July  
16, 1986.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-  
tions in Part C to read consecutively.

HOUSE AMENDMENT " " to H.P. 1748, L.D. 2433

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This amendment amends the Maine Revised Statutes,  
3 Title 22, section 7912, subsection 2, by deleting the  
4 reference to mobile nonambulatory residents because  
5 this subsection was intended to apply only to  
6 nonambulatory waiver residents. Subsection 1 of that  
7 section applies to mobile nonambulatory residents.
