11 Amend the bill in section 15 in that part desig-
12 nated "§1263." subsection 1, paragraph D in the 3rd
13 line (page 10, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined word "and"

15 Amend the bill in section 15 in that part desig-
16 nated "§1263." subsection 1, paragraph E, in subpara-
17 graph (3) in the 2nd line (page 11, line 2 in L.D.)
18 by striking out the following "program." and insert-
ing in its place the following "program; and'

20 Amend the bill in section 15 in that part desig-
21 nated "§1263." subsection 1 by inserting at the end
the following:

23 'F. That person has been incarcerated for the
first 90 days of his sentence.'

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment requires that any person who is
3 otherwise eligible for the Intensive Supervision Pro-
4 gram must have served at least 90 days of his sen-
5 tence while being incarcerated.
