HOUSE AMENDMENT "*D*" to H.P. 1758, L.D. 2439,
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a General Bond Issue in
the Amount of \$15,000,000 for Construction and
Renovation of Correctional Facilities."

Amend the bill in the title, in the 3rd line
(page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the
words "Renovation of" the word 'State'

Further amend the bill in the first paragraph af-
ter the title, in the last line (page 1, line 27 in
L.D.) by inserting after the words "renovation of"
the word 'state'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in the 2nd
line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the
word "renovation of" the word 'state'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in the 8th
line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by inserting after the
words "renovation of" the word 'state'

Further amend the bill in section 6, in the 3rd
and 4th lines (page 2, line 42 and page 3, line 1 in
L.D.) by striking out the words and punctuation "spe-
cific correctional facilities and locations within
the State," and inserting in their place the words
'specificly to state correctional facilities'

Further amend the bill in section 10, in the
question, in the 2nd line (page 3, line 37 in L.D.)
by inserting after the word "repair" the word 'state'
