21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
22 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
23 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate un-
25 til late summer or early fall of 1986; and

26 Whereas, Maine District Court 12, Franklin Divi-
27 sion offices must move out of the Franklin County
28 Courthouse by September 1, 1986, in order to be ac-
29 cessible to the handicapped; and

30 Whereas, the State may elect to lease land and
31 buildings for office space and parking for District
32 Court 12, Franklin Division, and other state offices
33 at property that may be acquired by the Farmington
34 Village Corporation; and
