18 19 20	AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Farmington Village Corporation.
21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
24 25	Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate un- til late summer or early fall of 1986; and
26 27 28 29	Whereas, Maine District Court 12, Franklin Divi- sion offices must move out of the Franklin County Courthouse by September 1, 1986, in order to be ac- cessible to the handicapped; and
30 31 32 33 34	Whereas, the State may elect to lease land and buildings for office space and parking for District Court 12, Franklin Division, and other state offices at property that may be acquired by the Farmington Village Corporation; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 P&SL 1911, c. 142, §2, as amended by P&SL 1947,
10 c. 80, is further amended by adding at the end the
11 following:

12 To purchase land and buildings for public offices and parking, and to expend money in the alteration 13 and extension of buildings purchased and for the con-14 struction of new buildings, and for the general im-15 16 provements of the land and buildings and for the pur-17 chase of fixtures and furnishings therefor, and for the operation thereof for those purposes; and to 18 19 lease without profit, except to recover costs of op-20 eration and maintenance costs of acquisition, including costs of amortization, costs of improvements and 21 costs of fixtures and furnishings, for office space 22 for federal, state, county or municipal offices and parking; and the Farmington Village Corporation at 23 24 25 any legal meeting called for that purpose may vote to sell the land, buildings, improvements, fixtures and 26 27 furnishings to the inhabitants of the Town of 28 Farmington at such time and for such sum of money as 29 voted. The property shall not be taxable by the Town 30 of Farmington.

31 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited 32 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-33 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

35 The purpose of this bill is reflected in the 36 emergency preamble.

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
