19 Computerization of the Personnel

22 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
23 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
24 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the on-going program to computerize the
26 personnel record-keeping system for all state employ-
27 ees is in immediate need of additional funding for
28 computer programming and related costs; and

29 Whereas, failure to complete this conversion pro-
30 gram promptly will jeopardize the State's ability to
31 comply with and implement the various collective bar-
32 gaining agreements which the State has with unions
33 representing state employees; and

34 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
35 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 **Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the
8 General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,
9 1987, to the department listed, the following sum:

21 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited

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STATEMENT OF FACT
