	AN ACT Providing Legislative Authorization Regarding Telecommunication Systems Lease Purchase for the Lewiston Office Complex.
	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
	Whereas, telecommunication systems for the Lewiston office complex require immediate attention and authorization action for the health and safety of the state employees and the public and for the prudent management of state activities; and
	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Authorization of the lease-purchase of certain telecommunications equipment. As required by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1587, approval is given to the Department of Administration through the Bureau of Public Improvements Telecommunications Division, to enter into purchase or lease with option to purchase or lease-purchase financing agreements for telecommunications systems and equipment with an outright purchase price of not more than \$150,000 for the Lewiston office complex in Lewiston, Maine. Consistent with Public Law 1983, chapter 824, Part P, subpart 3, reasonable charges for services may be made to the user agencies.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

19 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides the specific authority required by law for the lease-purchase of telecommunications systems with an outright purchase price of more than \$30,000 for telecommunications equipment, Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1587. A telecommunications system of not more than \$150,000 is required for the Lewiston office complex to operate most efficiently at least cost. It is more beneficial for the State to finance the system through a lease-purchase financing agreement than through a lease or outright purchase.
