17 AN ACT to Deorganize the Town of Benedicta.
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 Sec. 1. Deorganization of the Town of Benedicta.

22 The Town of Benedicta in Aroostook County is
23 deorganized, provided that the corporate existence,
24 powers, duties and liabilities of the town shall sur-
25 vive for the purposes of prosecuting and defending
26 all pending suits to which the town is, or may be, a
27 party and all needful process arising out of such
28 suits, including provisions for the payment of all or
29 any judgments or debts which may be rendered against
30 the town or exist in favor of any creditor.

31 Sec. 2. Unexpended school funds. The treasurer

32 of the town or any other person who has custody of
33 the funds of the town shall pay to the State Treasur-
34 er all unexpended school funds, which together with
35 the credits due the town for school purposes, are to
36 be used by the State Tax Assessor to settle any
