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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 647, Joint Resolution memorializing Ronald W. Reagan, President of the United States and John S. Herrington, Secretary of the United States Department of Energy not to locate a high level radioactive waste repository within the State of Maine.

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Amend the Joint Resolution by inserting before the 14th paragraph from the end the following:

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'WHEREAS, recent geodetic, geologic, historic and archeological evidence reveals that the crust in coastal Maine is subsiding, which indicates neotectonic activity; and

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WHEREAS, the explanation for the unusual cluster pattern for earthquake epicenters in Maine may be another expression of neotectonic activity and possible crustal strain; and

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WHEREAS, the 50 to 250-year probability computations for high magnitude earthquakes should be recalculated to include 5 to 10,000-year events; and'

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Further amend the Joint Resolution in the next to the last paragraph in the 2nd line by inserting after the words "not to" the words 'attempt to'

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
