Whereas, acts Emergency preamble. and of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;

Whereas, Resolve 1985, chapter 36, established special commission to study the utilization of vacant buildings at Pineland Center and required that the commission report its findings, together with any legislation to the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature; and Whereas, the commission, in its study, has deter-

32 33 mined that, as yet, there are no clear and decisive 34 answers how to best utilize the facility's resources 35 and that the special commission should continue its 36 study in order to evaluate the available options 37 resolve the best use of the vacant space; and

Whereas, since the deadline for the commission's
report established in the original resolve has ar-
rived, any extension of the commission's authority
must be enacted as emergency legislation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

11 Report of commission. Resolved: Notwithstanding Resolve 1985, c. 76, that the Special Commission to 12 Study the Utilization of Vacant Buildings at Pineland Center, as established by Resolve 1985, chapter 36, 13 14 shall continue its study and report its findings, to-15 gether with any necessary legislation, to the Gover-16 17 nor and the First Regular Session of the 113th Legis-18 lature not later than January 15, 1987.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
