Whereas, Acts of the Legis-22 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 23 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 24 Whereas, Public Law 1985, chapter 813, requires the Legislative Task Force on Railroads to submit its 25 report, together with any necessary legislation to 26 27 the Legislature prior to January 1, 1987; and 28 Whereas, the task force is unable to meet this 29 deadline; and

Whereas, it is necessary to continue a study of

the role of Maine's railroads and their relationship

to the State's economy; and
