STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Creation of a
Position of Executive Director and an
Associate Executive Director to the
Board of Registration in Medicine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

32 MRSA §3269, sub-§16 is enacted to read:

16. Executive director; associate executive di-
rector. The board may appoint an executive director
and an associate executive director who shall serve
at the pleasure of the board and who shall assist the
board in carrying out its administrative duties and
responsibilities under this chapter. The salary
range for the executive director shall be from
\$44,000 to \$59,500 and the salary range for the as-
sociate executive director shall be from \$29,500 to
\$42,000.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to authorize the
3 Board of Registration in Medicine to appoint neces-
4 sary personnel, an executive director and an as-
5 sociate executive director, in order that the board
6 may better perform its functions and duties in li-
7 censing and regulation of the practice of medicine.
8 The board has the ability to fund the positions au-
9 thorized in this bill within its own budget, making
10 additional appropriations unnecessary.

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
