- 21 The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over audit and program review shall 22 submit to the Legislature its evaluations and analy-23 ses of justification reports submitted pursuant to 24 section 507-A no later than 14 months after those re-25 26 ports are submitted to the Legislature.
