SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 13, L.D. 11,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Deny Certain State Funds to Any Per-
9 son Who Refused to Register Under the United States
10 Military Selective Services Act."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§12801."
12 by striking all of the first and 2nd paragraphs (page
13 2, lines 1 to 12 in L.D.) and inserting in their
14 place the following:

15

'1. Registration. If less than 90% of all per-
16 sons required to submit to registration, in compli-
17 ance with the United States Military Selective Ser-
18 vices Act, United States Code, Title 50, Section 451,
19 et seq., fail to register, then:

20

A. Any person who is required to register and
21 fails to do so is ineligible to receive any state
22 funded grant, scholarship or loan made available
23 to persons enrolled in post-secondary educational
24 programs; and

B. The officials who administer those financial
26 assistance programs may require an applicant to
27 submit written proof of registration prior to the
28 award of a post-secondary educational grant, loan
29 or scholarship.'
