22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 26 MRSA §663, sub-§3, ¶A, as amended by PL 1975,
25 c. 717, §5, is further amended to read:

26 A. Any individual employed in agriculture as de-
27 fined in the Maine Employment Security Law and
28 the Federal Unemployment Insurance Tax Law, ex-
29 cept when that individual performs services for
or on a farm with housing over 300,000 1,000,000
laying birds hens;

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill adjusts the Maine minimum wage coverage to recognize the increased size of average egg farms, while continuing to provide this coverage to employees on an extremely large unit.

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
