18 Resolve, to Provide for a Commemorative
19 Bicentennial Motor Vehicle License
20 Plate to Celebrate the Bicentennial
21 of the Town of Waterboro.

23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
24 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
25 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
26 and

27 Whereas, 1987 is the bicentennial of the estab-
28 lishment of the Town of Waterboro; and

29 Whereas, the Town of Waterboro wishes to issue
30 commemorative license plates to celebrate that bicen-
31 tennial; and

1 Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as
2 emergency legislation, the bicentennial year will be
3 nearly finished before those license plates can be
4 issued; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
10 therefore, be it

11 Authority. Resolved: That the Waterboro Bicenten-
12 nial Committee, established by the Town of Waterboro
13 at the annual town meeting, March 9, 1984, under Ar-
14 ticle 61 and March 8, 1986, under Article 67 of the
15 Town Warrant, is authorized to design, distribute and
16 sell reflectorized, commemorative, bicentennial,
17 simulated motor vehicle registration plates. The
18 committee shall promulgate such rules as it deems ap-
19 propriate with respect to the design, distribution
20 and sale of reflectorized, commemorative, bicenten-
21 nial, simulated motor vehicle registration plates.
22 No commemorative plates may be sold, distributed or
23 displayed which are not approved by the committee;
24 and be it further

25 Use. Resolved: That the commemorative bicenten-
26 nial plate, as established by this resolve, may be
27 displayed to replace the front registration plate on
28 any motor vehicle registered in this State, except
29 truck tractors, from January 1, 1987, to December 31,
30 1987. The commemorative bicentennial plate may be
31 displayed on motor vehicles, except truck tractors,
32 registered outside the State, but operated within
33 this State, in the same manner as provided for vehi-
34 cles registered in this State; and be it further

35 Fees. Resolved: That the price of the plates
36 shall be determined by the committee. The funds re-
37 ceived by the committee from the sale of the plates
38 shall be expended by the committee for the observance
39 of the bicentennial of the Town of Waterboro and for
40 other lawful purposes of the committee.

41 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
42 in the preamble, this Resolve shall take effect when
43 approved.
