NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the Liquor Licensing Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28 MRSA §701, sub-§7-A is enacted to read:

7-A. Incorporated civic organizations; more than one event. No more than 6 events annually, spirituous, vinous and malt liquor.....\$50 per event.
