COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 29, L.D. 30,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Additional Moose Hunting
Permits for In-State Residents."

Amend the Bill in subsection 4, in the 5th line
(page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-
ing: "10% 7%" and inserting in its place the follow-
ing: '10%'

Further amend the Bill by adding before the
statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an increase in dedicated
revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife of \$21,250 for fiscal year 1987-88. The es-
timated increase in dedicated revenue is based on the
proposed annual increase of 450 resident and 50 non-
resident moose hunting permits.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allocates 10% of the State's moose
hunting permits to nonresidents as currently in the
law. The original bill proposed changing this per-
centage to 7%.
