- 1 A. A valid Maine hunting license, if he is a 2 resident of the State; or
- 3 B. A valid Maine big game hunting license, if he 4 is a nonresident or alien.

5 The fee for a moose hunting permit is :25 for residents and \$200 for nonresidents and aliens. At the 6 7 time the permit is obtained, the permittee may desig-8 nate a subpermittee to hunt with him. The permittee may choose not to designate a subpermittee and hunt alone, but a subpermittee must always be accompanied 9 10 by the permittee while hunting moose. While hunting 11 12 moose each nonresident or alien hunter shall be in 13 possession of a valid Maine nonresident or alien big 14 game hunting license, whichever is applicable.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill provides for an additional 500 moose 17 hunting permits. The percentage of nonresident per-18 mits is also reduced in the bill so that the in-19 creased permits will go to resident hunters.
