HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to
H.P. 35, L.D. 36, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Substantive
Corrections in the County and Municipal Laws."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd
indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 15
to 18 in amendment) and inserting in its place the
following:

'Further amend the bill in section 24 by striking
out all of paragraph B (page 11, lines 6 to 11 in
L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

B. At the end of the list of candidates for each
office there shall be left as many blank spaces as
there are vacancies to be filled, in which a voter
may insert write in or paste a sticker with the
name and municipality of residence of any person
for whom he desires to vote. A sticker may not be
used to vote for a write-in candidate in any
election other than a primary election.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of
the 9th indented paragraph after the title (page 2,
lines 11 to 14 in amendment) and inserting in its
place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 75 by striking
out all of subsection 1-A (page 30, lines 28 to 32 in

1 L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

2 1-A. Write-in votes. In a city election, a voter
3 may write in or paste a sticker with the name and
4 municipality of residence of any person for whom the
5 voter desires to vote in the blank space provided at
6 the end of the list of candidates for office. A
7 sticker may not be used to vote for a write-in
8 candidate in any election other than a primary
9 election.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This amendment amends the committee amendment to
12 the bill making substantive corrections in the county
13 and municipal laws. This amendment makes the laws
14 governing municipal ballots the same as the laws
15 governing state ballots regarding the use of stickers
16 for write-in candidates.
