At the end of the list of candidates for each office there shall be left as many blank spaces as there are vacancies to be filled, in which a voter may insert write in or paste a sticker with the name and municipality of residence of any person for whom he desires to vote. A sticker may not be used to vote for a write-in candidate in any election other than a primary election.
25 26 27 28	Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 9th indented paragraph after the title (page 2, lines 11 to 14 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

l-A. Write-in votes. In a city election, a voter
may write in or paste a sticker with the name and
municipality of residence of any person for whom the
voter desires to vote in the blank space provided at
the end of the list of candidates for office. A
sticker may not be used to vote for a write-in
candidate in any election other than a primary
election.'

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends the committee amendment to the bill making substantive corrections in the county and municipal laws. This amendment makes the laws governing municipal ballots the same as the laws governing state ballots regarding the use of stickers for write-in candidates.
