20 21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Brennan has compiled a record of public service unique in modern Maine history, that has spanned more than 2 decades of public ser- vice to the State, during which time he has served in the House of Representatives and the State Senate, as Attorney General, as Governor and recently by being elected to the United States House of Representa- tives; and		
32 33 34	Whereas, the Honorable Joseph E. Brennan has con- tinuously and exclusively used a certain desk while serving 8 years as Maine's Governor; and

1 Whereas, this furniture has great meaning to 2 former Governor Brennan and would be a fitting 3 tribute to his long and outstanding service to the 4 State; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 therefore, be it

11 Transfer of certain state property authorized. 12 Resolved: That, in honor and recognition of former 13 Governor Joseph E. Brennan, the desk and chair used 14 by him while Governor of this State, which is now the 15 property of this State, be presented to him as a gift 16 on behalf of the State.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

21 The purpose of this resolve is stated in the 22 emergency preamble.
