STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this bill is to permit the issu-10 ance of registration plates with radio call letters 11 to licensed radio station operators now provided by 12 law upon payment of a one-time service fee of \$5 with 13 issuance of subsequent reregistration upon payment of 14 a \$5 service fee.

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
