17 AN ACT Relating to Initial Plates under the
18 Motor Vehicle Laws.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §192, 4th ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c.
23 109, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its
24 place:

25 Applications for registration plates, as pre-
26 scribed in this section, pertaining to owners of pas-
27 senger vehicles or motor vehicles of the station wag-
28 on type, pickup trucks, motorcycles or camper vehi-
29 cles, who are residents of this State and who hold a
30 valid amateur radio station license issued by the
31 Federal Communications Commission, shall be accompa-
32 nyed by a notarized proof of that license. Registra-
33 tion plates issued under this paragraph shall be in-

1 scribed with the official amateur radio call letters
2 of the applicant as assigned by the Federal Communi-
3 cations Commission. Registration plates provided un-
4 der this paragraph shall be issued upon payment of a
5 one-time service fee of \$5. Subsequent
6 reregistrations shall be issued upon payment of a \$5
7 service fee.

8 STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this bill is to permit the issu-
10 ance of registration plates with radio call letters
11 to licensed radio station operators now provided by
12 law upon payment of a one-time service fee of \$5 with
13 issuance of subsequent reregistration upon payment of
14 a \$5 service fee.
